The dog team's skills are to be observed by the evaluator during the test search using the criteria listed below. They are to be rated on a scale of 5 to 1, e.g. Excellent = 5, Above Average = 4, Average = 3, Below Average = 2, and Unacceptable = 1. Any category not observed receives a score of 3 and the notation N/O. The total score is to be entered at the bottom of this page. Note that if more than 3 of these criteria are not observed the evaluator(s) should decide whether the test should be redone.
